Background / Analysis:



The purpose of the City's Transportation Master Planning process is to develop a plan that will address improvements for both existing and future motor vehicle, bicycle, and pedestrian mobility, be a tool to guide development in and around the City, and provide strategies for achieving a safe and efficient multimodal transportation system. On January 20, 2017, Kimley Horn, the City's consultant for the project, led a day-long workshop with members of City staff and TxDOT to discuss priorities and areas of concern. An open house was held that same evening to allow residents of the City and County to voice their concerns.

This workshop will provide the City Council with a brief overview of the criteria that may be used to rank and prioritize transportation capital improvement projects and then Council will be given an opportunity to conduct a similar exercise to the one staff and residents completed.
