Of the seventeen accidents reported sixteen were classified as minor with one being classified as major. On April 18, 2012 a motorcycle accident was reported at 224 FM 2093. The driver of the motorcycle was transported to Hill Country Memorial Hospital and later transferred to University Hospital in San Antonio.
