Of the fourteen accidents reported thirteen were classified as minor, with one being classified as major. On Tuesday June 5th a two vehicle accident was reported at the intersection of US Hwy 290 East and the Hill Country University Center. The driver and passenger of one vehicle were transported to Hill Country Memorial Hospital for minor injuries.

Two cases of Burglary were investigated for the week. Several items were stolen from a residence on Pyka Road. Personal items and a set of keys were stolen from a vehicle parked on South Columbus Street.
