Of the seven accidents reported six were classified as minor, with one being classified as major. On 8-30-2012 a vehicle struck two pedestrians in the 100 block of East Ufer Street. One pedestrian was transported to Hill Country Memorial Hospital.

Officers are investigating four cases of Burglary of a Vehicle. The ignition of a GMC Yukon parked on Forest Trail Drive was damaged and items were stolen from the vehicle. A complainant, located on Pear Street, reported the driver side door of a Dodge Ram Pick up, damaged. A GMC Suburban, parked on East Austin Street, had the locking mechanism punched out, nothing was missing from the vehicle. A Garmin GPS was stolen from a vehicle located on East Austin Street.

Officers investigated a case of a Stolen Vehicle. The vehicle was stolen from East Highway Street, and later located at the Highland Oaks Apartments.

Officers investigated seven cases of Theft for the week. A complainant reported a stolen wallet. The Secret Garden reported a skirt stolen. A complainant reported a rifle stolen. Medication was reported stolen. Two reports of theft were classified as unfounded. HEB reported a gas drive off.
