Of the sixteen accidents reported all were classified as minor.

Officers investigated a Burglary of a Building. The complainant reported items stolen from a shed located in the back yard of a residence at 1009 Avenue C. The theft possibly occurred about three weeks prior, but was discovered while the owner was moving from the property.
