Of the twelve accidents reported eleven were classified as minor, with one being classified as major. On September 25, 2012 officers were dispatched to the intersection of Llano and Centre for an accident involving two vehicles. A driver and one passenger were taken to Hill Country Memorial Hospital by private transportation.

Officers investigated a Burglary of a vehicle. An officer was dispatched to 604 South Eagle where a suspect was seen taking items out of a vehicle. The owner did not pursue charges, however the suspect was arrested for a municipal warrant.

An officer investigated a report of a stolen vehicle. It was determined the vehicle had been repossessed.
