

**ORDINANCE 2019-04**

AN ORDINANCE TO ORDER A GENERAL ELECTION ON MAY 4, 2019 FOR THE CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG FOR THE PURPOSE OF ELECTING TWO (2) CITY COUNCILMEMBERS TO CITY COUNCIL; MAKING PROVISIONS FOR THE CONDUCT OF SUCH ELECTION AND RESOLVING OTHER MATTERS RELATED TO THE CONDUCT OF SUCH ELECTION

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS;

- 1) That a General Election is hereby ordered to be held on May 4, 2019 in the City of Fredericksburg, Texas for the purpose of electing two (2) City Councilmembers to City Council. Each City Councilmember elected shall serve a term of two years, with their terms terminating in May 2021, or when their successors are duly elected and qualified.
- 2) That at said election, for two (2) candidates and that the two (2) candidates receiving the highest number of votes for said City Council positions shall be elected to office.
- 3) That qualified persons desiring to be candidates for the aforementioned City Council Positions shall file for election as such candidates with the City Secretary beginning at 7:30 a.m. on the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January 2019 and not later than 5:00 p.m. on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2019.
- 4) Voting on Election Day and during early voting shall be done on with paper ballots and paper ballots being used for voting by mail, curbside voting and emergency voting. Votes cast in the May 4, 2019 election will be counted on Election Day at the polling place designated in this ordinance.
- 5) The polling place designated for Fredericksburg voting precincts City 1 and County 1,2,3, and 4 for voting in the May 4, 2019 General Election shall be held at the Fredericksburg Girl Scout Cabin located at 202 W. Austin Street, Fredericksburg, Texas and such polling place shall be open on said Election Day from 7:00a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
- 6) The polling place designated for Fredericksburg voting precincts City 1 and County 1, 2, 3, and 4 for Early Voting for the May 4, 2019 General Election shall be held at the Fredericksburg Girl Scout Cabin located at 202 W. Austin Street, Fredericksburg, Texas. Early Voting will be conducted from April 22 through April 30, 2019 and include the two (2) required 12 hour voting days; voting dates and times are as follows:





- 7) Applications for ballot by mail shall be mailed to Shelley Goodwin, Early Voting Clerk, 126 W. Main Street, Fredericksburg, Texas, 78624. Applications for ballots by mail must be received by the Early Voting Clerk no later than the close of business on April 23, 2019.
- 8) The Presiding Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge appointed to conduct the May 4, 2019 General Election are as follows:

- 9) The Presiding Judge shall appoint at least two (2) clerks to assist in the proper conduct of the election.
- 10) The Presiding Judge and at least two (2) clerks shall serve as the Early Voting Ballot Board of said election.
- 11) The Presiding Judge, Alternate Presiding Judge and election clerks shall be paid at the rate of \$10.00 per hour.
- 12) Shelley Goodwin will serve as Early Voting Clerk and Margie Rivera as Deputy Early Voting Clerk to assist the Early Voting Clerk in the proper conduct of Early Voting for the May 4, 2019 General Election.
- 13) The notice of the May 4, 2019 General Election of the City of Fredericksburg will be posted and published in accordance with the Election Code of the State of Texas.
- 14) If any portion of this Ordinance is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions of this Ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.
- 15) That this Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
