I would like to comment on Agenda Item #: 5, public comment

COMMENTS: I have a question, has the city of Fredericksburg been granted immunity from liability for authorization and use of the covid vaccine? Given that the manufacturers have been granted this immunity, I am concerned that this immunity is not passed down to the various entities that have decided to use the experimental agent on people. Considering also that the FDA has authorized its use only under emergency conditions, it stands to reason any entity deciding to use the vaccine must first declare such an emergency, and thereby, accept responsibility for its use.

Historically, damages from medical treatments take years to surface, and then a few more years to litigate responsibility. Having asked our elected officials and some of the city staff about our disaster declaration, responses have avoided any mention of covid vaccine. But the connection is clear and the possible future is daunting.
