## MINUTES OF CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING MAY 14, 2022

The City of Fredericksburg City Council held their special session on Saturday, May 14, 2022, at 9:00 a.m. This meeting was held in person at the City Hall Conference Room.

### 1. CALL TO ORDER

Mayor Kiehne called the regular meeting of the Fredericksburg City Council to order at 9:00 a.m. on Saturday, May 14, 2022. Mayor Kiehne announced a quorum of the City Council present.

The City Council voted four (4) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried unanimously.

B. Consider the approval of Resolution 2022-08R canvassing the election results of the May 7, 2022, General Election; and declaring a Mayor and two Councilmembers elected to office.

**Motion:** A motion was made by Councilmember Musselman, seconded by Mayor Kiehne to approve Resolution 2022-08R canvassing the election results of the May 7, 2022, General Election; and declaring a Mayor and two Councilmembers elected to office, Jeryl Hoover, as Mayor and Emily Kirchner and Tony Klein, as Councilmembers to a term ending in May 2024. The City Council voted four (4) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Musselman stated it was a pleasure serving the community for the last 11 years. He pledged to stay an active member of the community.

Mayor Kiehne stated it was an honor to serve the community for the last 6 years. He also wished the new Council the best of luck.
