

RESOLUTION 2020-07R

WHEREAS, on March 19, 2020, Mayor Linda Langerhans declared a local state of disaster for the City of Fredericksburg, due to concerns related to the coronavirus pandemic (COVID-19) (the “disaster declaration”); and


WHEREAS, the Texas Government Code provides that such a declaration of disaster may not be continued for a period of more than seven days, except with the consent of the governing body of the political subdivision; and

WHEREAS, the City Council unanimously approved a motion at the March 23, 2020 meeting to consent to the continuation of the disaster declaration indefinitely.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FREDERICKSBURG, TEXAS:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby consents to the disaster declaration signed by Mayor Linda Langerhans on March 19, 2020, and amended on March 20, 2020, and consents to its continuation indefinitely, until such time as it is terminated by order of the Mayor or the City Council.
