## **What to bring to the polls.**

### **All Voters!**

You are required to produce a photo ID to vote, there are seven accepted forms:

1. Texas Driver License issued by the Texas Department of Public Safety (DPS)
2. Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS
3. Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS
4. Texas Handgun License issued by DPS
5. United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph
6. United States Passport (book or card)

### **All must be original not a copy – may not be expired more than 4 years**

7. United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph

### **Must be original not a copy – Cannot be expired must be current**

What if I don't have any of the forms of ID? Can I vote? Short answer is YES...

Here's how

You don't have an ID because you cannot reasonably obtain one, you can vote by filling out an affidavit. Ask for the affidavit and they will provide one at the voting location. You will have to produce additional documents to support the affidavit.

- Current utility bill
- Bank statement
- Government check or paycheck
- Other government documents that shows voter's name and address

You can vote a Provisional ballot. Ask for a Provisional ballot and the workers will explain the process to you.
