


Department Volume

Fiscal Years




Department Incidents by Day & Hour





Brush Fire Calls by Fiscal Year 2024-2025






Annual Number of Transfers

Transfers per Year










Incident Locations by Mutual Aid

5,307 (99.0%) incidents have coordinates out of 5,358 incidents total. Incidents without coordinates are not shown.

Summary for Fiscal 2025

- Demand for services continues to grow
- In FY2025 no specific cause was identified for the 10.2% increase
- Increases occurred across the board in all categories of services
- EMS calls continue to be the major type, 78.4% of all calls.
- Urban (City) and Remote Districts made up the highest growth. Urban +216 calls, Remote +223 calls over 2024.
- Time of day growth had Day time up 13.7%, night growth up 4.5%.
- Mutual Aid calls with all County Departments were 15.5% of all calls.











2025 Arrests by Month










2015-2025 Warning and Citations




2018-2025 Accidents




2015-2025 Arrests




Citizen Positive Satisfaction Score (CPSS)

2025 Summary

- Demand for services continues to grow
- 10% increase in calls for service – 20% over 2023
 - 7% increase in traffic accidents
- 25% increase in arrests
 - 36% of all arrests occurred between 12 AM and 6 AM
 - 53% of all arrests were DWI and PI
 - 54% of all arrests were visitors
 - 64% of DWI arrests were visitors
 - 62% of PI arrests were visitors
